Safari Itinerary

DAY 01: Welcome to Nairobi, Kenya's Bustling Capital

Once you arrive at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), you'll be warmly received by HTT Operations Manager, who will give you a short brief of your safari. You will then be transferred by private vehicle to Movenpick Hotel located in the heart of Westlands, Nairobi's commercial, retail and entertainment suburb about 20 kilometers from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport.



Honeymooners will be welcomed with a bouquet of roses for the bride.

Meal plan: Bed and breakfast basis

DAY 02: Explore Nairobi City - Excursions

0700hrs: Enjoy an early morning breakfast at Movenpick Hotel & Residences to get you started on your Nairobi City Excursions, In short to explore the city and its attractions.

Nairobi is popularly known as the Green City under the Sun.

On this day, you will enjoy the following popular excursions:-

- Giraffe Centre; which protects the highly endangered Rothschild's giraffe.
- David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust; an orphanage for young elephants.
- Nairobi City tour and much more.

You will have lunch at the famous Carnivore restaurant

1830 hrs: Return to the lodge for dinner and then overnight

DAY 03: Nairobi - Sweetwaters, Ol Pejeta

0700hrs: Wake up to a sumptuous buffet breakfast at Movenpick Hotel & Residences and then check out.

0800hrs: Depart after breakfast for Sweetwaters Serena Camp, which is located in the world famous Ol Pejeta Conservancy. You will enjoy spectacular views along the road, you'll just love it!

Note: The drive takes approximately 3.5 hours.

Ol Pejeta has been advocating for the plight of chimpanzees and other great apes since 1993 at the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary. The Sanctuary aims to provide a refuge for chimpanzees rescued from the black market, and is the only place in Kenya where these fascinating animals can be seen. Ol Pejeta also offers refuge to the rhino.



1130hrs approximately, arrive at Sweetwaters Serena Camp in time for lunch. You'll spend the afternoon at your own leisure.

Enjoy a plethora of experiences and activities during your visit to Sweetwaters Serena Camp. Their unmatched location within the Ol Pejeta Conservancy enables you to take part in everything from game drives and lion tracking to scenic bird walks along the river.



1600hrs: Enjoy an evening game drive on private basis

1830hrs: Return to Sweetwaters Serena Camp for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 04: Sweetwaters - Lake Naivasha

Buffet breakfast at Sweetwaters Serena Camp, then depart for Lake Naivasha and arrive at Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge in time for lunch. You can spend the afternoon at your own leisure.



Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake in the Kenya section of Africa's Great Rift Valley, and is located north west of Nairobi with the town of Naivasha on its north eastern shore.

The lake is home to a wide variety of wildlife including a sizeable population of hippos. Being a freshwater lake, it also has a healthy fish population to include Black bass, Tilapia and Crayfish which attract a variety of fish-eating birds such as Long-tailed and Great Cormorants, along with Fish Eagles, Pelicans, and various types of Kingfishers.

Naivasha is also a good place to see the Grey-backed fiscal. This bird replaces the Long-tailed Fiscal in areas with higher rainfall. Also to be seen in the area is the Black-lored Babbler. The Naivasha race tends to show pale tipped feathers on their heads which gives their appearance a somewhat frosty or haloed effect, and it is believed that this variation may be the result of hybridization with Northern Pied Babbler at some point in the past.

This time can be used doing a boat ride or a visit to Crescent Island – see rates below on “Extras”.
Dinner and then overnight at the Resort.



DAY 05: Lake Naivasha – Masai Mara National Reserve

0630 hrs Enjoy an early morning buffet breakfast at the Resort, then depart for Maasai Mara National Reserve, which is also known as the “**Jewel of Kenya**”. On your way to Maasai Mara National Reserve, you will enjoy different array of views which are just priceless.

The Maasai Mara National Reserve is one of the most popular safari destinations in Africa. The Maasai Mara is regarded as the jewel of Kenya’s wildlife viewing areas. There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians and reptiles and over 450 birds species recorded on the reserve.

Nowhere in Africa is wildlife more abundant, and it is for this reason a visitor hardly misses to see the big five (**buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhino**). Other animals that can be spotted here include hippos, cheetahs, gazelles, antelopes, zebras, giraffes, dik-dik, and warthogs among others.

The annual wildebeest’s migration alone involves over 1.5 million wildebeests, zebras, gazelles and other animals that cross over from the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara in search of pasture and water. They cross the Mara River in July and make the return journey in late October/November. The migration, especially the Mara River crossing has been dubbed one of the 8th wonders of the modern world.



1240hrs appx: Arrive at Masai Mara National Reserve; you will have game drive enroute to your lodge which is Mara Sopa Lodge. Later have a sumptuous lunch at the lodge.

The distance is approximately 4.5 hrs.

Spend the afternoon at your own leisure. You can relax in your comfortable room.

Located high on the slopes of the Oloolaimutia Hills, Maasai Mara Sopa Lodge was one of the first safari lodges to be built in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, a reason why its gardens and trees are so lush and mature. All the buildings follow the design of traditional African round houses with conical roofs, and these stretch along the line of the hills with the impressively large public area buildings and the swimming pool at their centre.



1600hrs: Enjoy an evening game drive on shared basis to the expansive Mara plains.

1830hrs: Return to Mara Sopa lodge for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 06: Enjoy Captivating Full Day in the Maasai Mara

0630hrs: Wake up for a refreshing hot cup of coffee or tea. Then depart for a morning game drive to explore the Mara plains and its intriguing wildlife.

Alternatively:-

You can opt for a Hot Air Balloon Safari instead of a morning game drive.

This is truly a fun and exciting way to see Africa's landscapes and wildlife.



The trip is magical: spend about one hour floating over the Mara plains. You float in the sky, drift with the whim of the wind, overlooking the plains, just in time to experience a breathtaking sunrise and catch a bird's eye view of the reserve.

The cost includes Balloon Safari + Out of Africa Bush Breakfast. A certificate will be presented by the pilot after the ride.

0830hrs: Return to the lodge for a full buffet breakfast and spend the morning at your own leisure.

1230hrs: Enjoy a scintillating buffet lunch at the lodge.

Afternoon spent at leisure. You can relax by the swimming pool or you can visit a traditional Maasai Village where you'll get insight into the vibrant and traditional way of life of the Maasai.

1600hrs: Depart for an evening game drive.

1830hrs: Return to the Lodge for dinner and then overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge.

DAY 07: Maasai Mara – Mombasa Serena Beach Resort

0730hrs: - Check out after breakfast and head back to Nairobi.

1300hrs: - Arrive in Nairobi, where you can have lunch (on own).

Drop off at the JKIA for flight to Mombasa – this is a 1 hour flight.

We recommend booking a flight departing from Nairobi at 1600 hrs to allow enough time to check in.

Upon arrival into Mombasa Moi Airport, you'll be met by HTT staff and transferred to 5-star Mombasa Serena Beach Resort.

The rest of the day you are free to relax at you comfortable room or take a relaxing stroll along the sandy white beaches.



Please note

1. Soft-sided luggage or duffels are preferable to hard luggage for storage on safari vehicles within East Africa. Large suitcases of dimensions greater than 24"x 17"x 7" are impossible to store in vehicles and on aircraft and should not be used. (Baggage and personal effects are at owner's risk throughout the tour and baggage insurance for members is strongly advised). **Luggage limit of one soft bag per person during travel in Kenya/Tanzania. Hard cases should be avoided as they cannot fit in safari vehicles**
 2. Baggage on Internal Scheduled Flights: if applicable
Baggage allowance is 15 kg per person
Extra luggage will be charged each kilo basis subject to availability of space.
 3. **Non A/C Vehicles are used for transfers in Nairobi and on Safari in Kenya & Tanzania**
 4. **PASSPORT SHOULD BE VALID AT LEAST 6 MONTHS BEYOND PERIOD OF STAY.**
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5. DUTY OF THE CLIENT TO CHECK VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRAVEL.
